Important Reciprocity Information

- Members of the interstate reciprocal clubs/venues above will have entry entitlements into the SACA Member's Enclosure at Adelaide Oval for:
 1. Commonwealth Bank Test Match Days 4 and 5 only (Tuesday 5th Dec & Wednesday 6th Dec 2017)
 2. KFC T20 Big Bash League minor round matches. Information available via www.saca.com.au once the fixture has been released.
- There will be no reciprocal tickets available for Days 1 to 3 of the Commonwealth Bank Test Match or the One Day International match on Australia Day.
- Reciprocal members must be on a short term visit and permanently reside outside of South Australia. For international matches a member must attach a copy of their membership card and proof of identification confirming residence outside of South Australia with all reciprocity applications.
- Reciprocal tickets for the Commonwealth Bank Test Match Day 4 will be available through a ballot by completing the attached form. The ballot will be open from **Thursday 30th March to Sunday 23rd April 2017** and drawn Monday 24th April.
- **Reciprocal members can ballot for one reciprocal ticket for themselves plus one additional visitor ticket.**
- Reciprocal tickets for Day 4 will be available for collection from the Membership Services window located at the Southern Ticket Box, in the Southern Plaza (off War Memorial Drive).
- Reciprocal tickets for the Commonwealth Bank Test Match Day 5 will be available on Day 5 from the Membership Services Window located at the Southern Ticket Box, in the Southern Plaza (off War Memorial Drive).
- If tickets are remaining after the ballot, these can be purchased from the SACA office. Please contact SACA on (08) 8300 3232 from 28th April to confirm availability of tickets prior to your arrival.
- There is a **limit** of daily tickets available for all reciprocal members. Tickets will be allocated through the ballot and once the allocation has been exhausted, reciprocity will no longer be available.
- In the event of being unsuccessful in the ballot, General Public tickets can be purchased through:
 1. Australian Cricket Family (ACF) pre-sale from 1st May 2017. (Please note, you must sign up to the free ACF via <http://www.cricket.com.au/acf-register> no later than 23rd April to be eligible for the ACF pre-sale tickets.)
 2. General Public tickets on sale from 8th May via Cricket Australia.
- Please note all reciprocal tickets purchased are non-refundable unless the National Refund Policy (NRP) applies. NRP can be found at www.cricket.com.au. If the NRP applies for Day 4 you will automatically receive a refund to the credit card used to purchase tickets.
- Member Dress standards are strictly enforced at Adelaide Oval. Please visit the Membership tab at www.saca.com.au for Member Dress Code standards.
