



UMPIRE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

In conjunction with other WACA training programs the Umpire Development Program aims to develop officials that will have a holistic view of the roles, responsibilities and requirements of elite level officiating. It provides an officiating framework to the umpire around which long term skills can be developed. This program is aimed at those umpires that have completed the CA Level 2 Accreditation, have already had some (one or two years at senior WACA district cricket level) officiating experience and who have the desire to develop to the elite level of umpiring. These umpires must demonstrate this commitment to their development by actively participating in all other aspects of training and development offered by the WACA.

Session 5 Wed 15th Dec – Coping with success and failure.
